How to Pair a Bluetooth Printer to the XM66

1. Open the Wireless Manager by tapping the blue wireless icon next to "WiFi: Network Card".

2. Tap the "Menu" icon at the bottom right corner of the screen.

3. Tap "Add". (Make sure that the printer is in a "discoverable" mode.)
